### • Dormitory

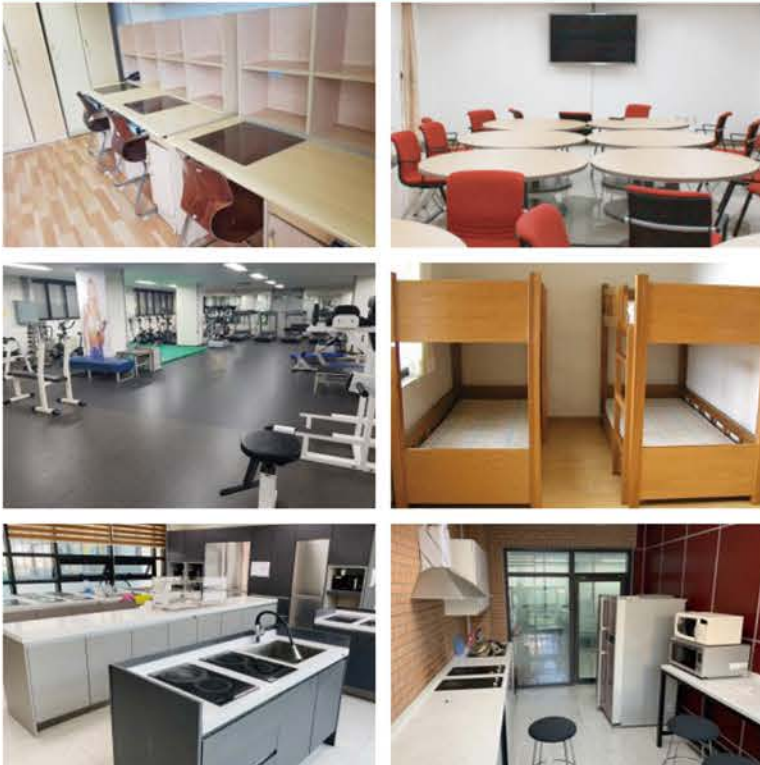
- 4 people / Room

- ※ Dormitory curfew is at midnight. If you are planning to stay out overnight, you must come to the international office in advance to inform and fill up a form.
