Objectives	⇔	To enable selected applicants to undertake a PhD at one of the 10 Swiss cantonal universities, the two Swiss federal institutes of technology or public teaching and research institutes.

Teaching and research institutes	⇔	Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies (IHEID)	
Validity	⇔	The scholarship is only valid for full-time PhD studies in Switzerland. It is not valid for mixed PhD programmes (part time in Switzerland and part time in another country).	
Target group	⇔	Highly qualified postgraduate students (possessing the required degrees) from all academic fields.	
Duration	⇔	3 years maximum (starting in September)	
Amount and additional allowances	ዮዮ ዮዮ	The scholarship amounts to a monthly payment of CHF 1'920. For non-EU and non-EFTA grantees only: mandatory Swiss health insurance is paid by the FCS. There are no family allowances. Scholarship holders from outside continental Europe receive a flight allowance (lump sum) for a ticket back to their country of origin (provided at the end of the scholarship).

		willing to supervise and support the PhD thesis. Without such support, the
		application will be rejected.
	⇔	Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe. This is
		the centrepiece of the application. The applicant must devote all required attention to it.
	⇔	Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required
		for the PhD studies/ research.
	⇔	Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government
		Excellence Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship.
	⇔	Scholarship holders are expected to move to Switzerland during their grant
		period.

	⇔	The FCS application for a PhD scholarship and the application for
		admission by a Swiss University for a PhD study are two separate
		procedures.
	⇔	The admission to a PhD study at your chosen Swiss University is a <i>conditio</i>
		sine qua non for a potential attribution of a FCS scholarship - but no
		guarantee though for a positive decision by the Federal Commission for
		Scholarships for Foreign Students FCS. It is the applicant's responsibility to
		manage both procedures in parallel.
	⇔	In those cases where the PhD is run within a structured doctoral school*,
	~	applicants must include in their application an admission letter or proof that
		they are being considered for admission. Without such a document, the
		application will be rejected. A support letter is required in any case
		additionally.
	⇔	For EPFL doctoral school candidates*, the admission letter from the EPFL
		doctoral school is required before the application. As this takes time applicants must plan accordingly and submit their application for admission
		to the doctoral school sufficiently in advance of the scholarship programme
		deadline. Without those documents the application will be rejected.

The other two sets are the copies of the 1 st set except for the confidential letters of recommendation (only 1 st set).			
	1) 2)	 A full CV with list of academic publications. A motivation letter (max. 2 pages). A complete research proposal (max. 5 pages, signed), using exclusively the FCS research proposal form. A copy of the letter from an academic host professor (including her/his short CV) at the chosen Swiss university confirming why she/he is willing supervise and support the PhD thesis. For PhD scholarships at doctoral schools*: A proof that the applicant is being considered for admission. Except: EPF accepted admission required. *A support letter from a host professor is required in any case additionally Two confidential letters of recommendation from two different professors is the applicant's field (use exclusively the FCS reference form – originals in sealed envelopes only for the 1st set). Photocopies of certificates and grade sheets from previously attended universities/colleges and diplomas with grades, starting with the most recent. If not in English, French, Italian or German with attested certified translations.
